The Board of Supervisors of Fayette County, Iowa, met on July 26th, 2010, at 9:00 o'clock a.m., at the Fayette County Supervisor's office.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairperson, and the roll was called showing the following Supervisors present and absent:

Motion was made by Gayle Tellin and seconded by Mike Kennedy to approve the current agenda. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Mike Kennedy and seconded by Gayle Tellin to approve the minutes for the July 19th, 2010 meeting. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

RESOLUTION # 147

Be it resolved by Fayette County that Aaron S. Burkes, UERPC Executive Director, is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of Fayette County, this mitigation project and to file it with Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management (HSEMD) for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (PL 93-288, as amended) and the Code of Iowa, Chapter 29c. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the resolution was adopted.

Motion was made by Mike Kennedy and seconded by Gayle Tellin to appoint Ron Moser as a Commissioner of Veterans Affairs, to fill a vacancy. On roll call all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Gayle Tellin and seconded by Mike Kennedy to abate the taxes on Chicago Northwestern Trans. Co. (Parcel #18-21-157-021). This parcel was quit claim deeded to D & W Railroad, Inc. in 2003. On roll call all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

ASPIRE (Automated Statewide Portal for Integrated Real Estate & Election data), a 28E entity to which Fayette County was affiliated, was dissolved at Noon on July 1, 2010, due to the inability of Iowa Interactive and the Auditors' Affiliate to sell real estate from the CREW website.

Kathleen Streif has been employed by the Fayette County Sheriff's Office as a Detention Officer for 3 years. Her pay will increase to \$15.07 per hour effective 6/28/2010.

Motion was made by Gayle Tellin and seconded by Mike Kennedy to approve the purchase of a 2011 Ford F250 C Cab truck from Wilbur Ford for \$27,440 for the Fayette County Road Department Quarry.

Motion was made by Mike Kennedy and seconded by Gayle Tellin to approve the purchase of two 2010 Ford F150 S Cab trucks from Wilbur Ford for \$21,875 each for use by the Fayette County Road Department Inspectors.
